## Pre-issue instalments

Pre-issue instalments allow you to set up extra instalments that are due in the in the financial year *after* the one you are creating the budget for. This is useful if you aren't able to get a budget approved until after the first levies should be due. For example, if you are setting up a budget for a financial year from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2021 and you should have levies that are due on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 but the AGM isn't conducted until 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 - leading to a situation where levies would already be past due by the time you have the budget approved. Setting pre-issues for the following year means that you won't be in that situation next year.

The budget process also allows you to manually enter any pre-issues you might have already generated (outside the budgeting process)

The number of pre-issues is set on the building card dates tab. You can set up to four pre-issues for each building.



This building has one pre-issue, but you can set up to four pre-issues if you need to.

- 1. If you have previously issued a pre-issue levy outside PropertyIQ you will need to enter the amount of the pre-issue here. This will reduce the individual instalments by the amount entered (the figure you enter is divided equally between all instalments and increase the total budget per UOE by the amount you enter here.
- 2. Each pre-issue for next year is the same per UOE as this year's instalments, but you can alter by overtyping on this screen if you need to.-
